

NOMINATIONS COMMITTEE OF TOWN OF CHEVY CHASE VIEW

April 3, 2023

Dear Resident:

On Thursday, May 11, 2023, the regular election in and for Chevy Chase View will be held for the purpose of electing two members to the Council of Chevy Chase View for a term of two years each. The Council members whose terms expire are Peter Marks, Nancy Somerville, and Ed Tarbutton.

Council members are reimbursed \$25.00 for each regular meeting attended. Each person elected is required to qualify within ten days, by taking an oath before any officer in Montgomery County authorized by law to administer oaths, to discharge faithfully all duties of the office. The newly elected officials take office as soon as qualified.

Pursuant to the Chevy Chase View Charter, each eligible voter of Chevy Chase View is entitled to nominate candidates for the offices for which elections are being held. All registered and qualified voters of Montgomery County residing in Chevy Chase View who are 18 years of age or older on the date of the election are eligible to vote in this election.

All nomination forms, properly completed and signed, shall be delivered to any member of the Nominations Committee (below) on or before April 21, 2023. Please use the nomination form enclosed with this notice.

The Hatch Act and regulations adopted pursuant thereto permit federal employees to participate (including holding office) in "non-partisan" elections such as Chevy Chase View's election.

After the nominations are received, it shall be the duty of the Nominations Committee to determine the willingness of eligible nominees to serve if elected. If any nominee shall signify his or her unwillingness to accept the office to which he or she has been nominated, the name of such nominee shall thereupon be stricken from the list of candidates for such office. Those who accept nomination will be requested to provide the Nominations Committee with a short biography by April 23, 2023, for distribution to the voters with the list of candidates. As a result of the amendment to the Chevy Chase View Charter the Council adopted in December 2005, in the event there is an uncontested election (i.e., three positions open and only three candidates who are nominated agree to run for election), there would be no balloting and the three candidates would be deemed elected to the Council.

The election will be held from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 11, 2023, at Christ Episcopal Church, 4001 Franklin Street, Kensington, Maryland.
