The Work Session was called to order by Paula Fudge at 4:10 p.m.

At its November 17, 2021 monthly meeting, the Council requested a proposal from Clark/Azar to add a landscape architectural firm to the project team. Landscape architecture and engineering firms frequently team together on-site design and green infrastructure projects, and some design firms have both engineers and landscape architects on staff. Clark/Azar does not have a landscape architecture division, but they could bring a landscape architecture firm on board as a consultant. With the Town's DNR grant proposal submission deadline of December 14, 2021, the Council will rely on Clark/Azar for its budget projections, which need to factor in required consultants' costs.

After considerable discussion, Nancy Somerville moved that the projection of costs for use in the DNR Grant Application with a total cost of \$69,052 be approved. Pete Marks seconded the motion and it passed with a 4-0 vote.
