Approval of Minutes of November 15, 2017 Monthly Meeting Minutes: Nancy Kehne moved the minutes of the October 18, 2017 Monthly Meeting be approved. Ron Sherrow seconded the motion and it passed by a vote of 5-0.

Financial Report for Period November 1, 2017 to November 30, 2017:

Nancy Kehne moved that the financial report for the period November 1, 2017 to November 30, 2017 be accepted. Paula Fudge seconded the motion and it passed by a vote of 5-0.

<u>Council Member Walk</u>: Nancy Kehne conducted the monthly Council member walk and did not have any issues to report.

Ratify Issuance of CCV Permit No. 409-11005 - Front Walk to street - 4301 Glenridge Street (Walters): Jerry and Nicole Walters submitted a building permit revision for their home at 4301 Glenridge Street, in the Town of Chevy Chase View. The application complies with all of the applicable rules and restrictions of the Chevy Chase View Municipal Code.

Mr. Toomey's review is based upon a description of the revision on the application, as well as a section of the original site plan with the revision overlaid onto it. The scope of the change is to add a front walkway from the front porch to the curb at the street. The walkway will be a three-foot wide, bluestone slate, on a concrete slab base. The site plan indicates that the walkway may have steps, as needed, for the change in grade, and that it will curve to meet the curb at a point 20 feet away from the existing right-of-way tree.

A building permit from the Montgomery County Department of Permitting Services is not needed. Mr. Toomey recommended on November 16, 2017, that the Council should approve the application. The Council unanimously approved the permit application via email on November 30, 2017. Paula Fudge moved that the permit for the front walk be ratified. Nancy Kehne seconded the motion and it passed by a vote of 5-0.

Progress Report on WSSC Cedar Lane Roadway Restoration and Removal of Existing Side Islands and Installation Center Islands: WSSC has advised the Town that its paving contractor, M T Laney, expects to complete the milling/paving, as well as striping by December 22nd.

Montgomery County Department of Transportation has informed the Town that it will address the Summit Avenue serious safety issues regarding vehicles traveling north of Dresden Street toward Summit Avenue/Cedar Lane intersection when the paving and striping is completed.

Update on SHA Safety Study of Connecticut Avenue between Saul Road and Washington Street: The Town awaits the date when SHA officials will be conducting a meeting to share preliminary assessments of the ongoing 90-day study. This study is a result of the Town's request that SHA study operational and multi-modal safety impacts along MD 185 between Saul Road and Washington Street. The study began in early September when normal traffic patterns resumed.

<u>Town Logo and Seal Design Discussion:</u> The Town Council reviewed and considered options for soliciting Town logo and seal designs.

Building Permit Application - Roof Overhang for New Entry Door - 4013

Glenrose Street (Gonella): Donna and Jon Gonella submitted a building permit application for their home at 4301 Glenridge Street, in the Town of Chevy Chase View. The application complies with all of the applicable rules and restrictions of the Chevy Chase View Municipal Code.

Mr. Toomey's review is based upon the description of the project on the application, the Location Drawing produced by Capitol Surveys, Inc, dated February 4, 2016, with the project location overlaid on the drawing, and a sketch of the proposed work. The scope of the project is to construct a 3-foot by 6-foot 8-inch roof over a new entry door to be constructed on the side of their home. The new roof will be setback approximately 22 feet from the left (west) side property line. A porch

roof is allowed to project 2 feet into a side setback requirement and could be as close as 13 feet from a side property line. Mr. Toomey recommended approval of this application. A permit from Montgomery County will also be required for this project.

Nancy Kehne moved that the permit for the door overhang be approved. Tom Brown seconded the motion it passed by a vote of 5-0.

<u>Motion to Adjourn</u>: At 8:20 p.m., Nancy Kehne moved the meeting be adjourned. Tom Brown seconded the motion and it passed by a vote of 5-0.

Leaf Removal Ends on December 31, 2017: Hughes Landscaping, Inc. will remove all leaves on a weekly basis, weather permitting, until December 31, 2017. Please do not mix your grass clippings with the leaves at the curb.

Leaves are to be placed at curbside and made accessible for truck pickup. Sticks, trash, rocks and other rubbish will not be collected and should be bagged for normal trash pickup. Leaves should not be shredded or bagged. For the residents on Connecticut Avenue, Cedar Lane, Kensington Parkway and Saul Road, your leaves also will be picked up weekly. Please rake your leaves to the sidewalk. For liability reasons, do not place leaves on our sidewalks. In the event that you do not have a sidewalk, please rake your leaves as close to the street as possible.

Bulk Pick-Up - The next monthly bulk pick-up is scheduled on Saturday, January 6, 2018. As a reminder, heavy refuse includes major appliances (must have Freon removed), furniture, large toys, bicycles, and plumbing fixtures. Excluded are batteries, propane tanks, bricks, general construction debris and iron pipes. Please have your items at the curb by 7:00 AM on Saturday as the truck comes through early.

<u>Maintenance of Shrubbery between Curb and Private Property:</u> This is a friendly reminder to clear or trim shrubbery growing over sidewalks and maintain the area between your property and the street curb.

Please note that the review may take several days and an application is not considered perfected until the Town Permit Administrator-Municipal Engineer completes his review.
